CRITERIA FOR A NEW DIVISION

1. An application for a new division received by the Commission (WASC) must include the following:
 - A copy of the Certificate of Incorporation.
 - A copy of the Constitution with the official seal of the Department of Consumer and Employment Protection.
 - A declaration that the Association has a minimum of 20 financial members.
 - A declaration that the Association has a minimum of 10 race ready vehicles, and,
 - Copy of specifications detailing a 25% difference in engine, body and chassis requirements from any existing division.

PROCESS FOR A NEW DIVISION

2. The application and supporting information is passed to the Safety and Regulations Advisory Committee (SRAC) to:
 - a. identify and report to the WASC Board any relevant safety issues.
 - b. Recommend that the WASC Board authorises a meeting between the SRAC and the committee of the new division to explore the reasons for creating a new division,

or,
 - c. Recommend that the WASC Board acts as a mediator between the relevant state body (existing division) and the new division to endeavour to reconcile differences.
3. Following the meeting with the committee of the new division the SRAC is to report to the WASC Board recommending whether or not affiliation should be granted.
4. Once the new division meets the criteria the WASC Board may approve or decline the application.
5. Following the WASC Board mediation role: (Clause 2.c. above)
 - a. If mediation is successful the application may be withdrawn.
 - b. If mediation is not successful the WASC Board may approve or decline the application.
6. The SRAC may create scrutineering guidelines for the new division, if applicable.
